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15 Complainant Roman G. Porter, Executive Director of the Fair Political Practices Commission,
16 and Respondents Joel Anderson and Taxfighters for Anderson Assembly 2010 (“Respondents”), hereby
17 agree that this Stipulation will be submitted for consideration by the Fair Political Practices Commission
18 at its next regularly scheduled meeting.

19 The parties agree to enter into this Stipulation to resolve all factual and legal issues raised in this
20 matter and to reach a final disposition without the necessity of holding an administrative hearing to
21 determine the liability of Respondents.

22 Respondents understand, and hereby knowingly and voluntarily waive, any and all procedural
23 rights set forth in Sections 83115.5, 11503 and 11523 of the Government Code, and in Section 18361.1
24 through 18361.9 of Title 2 of the California Code of Regulations. This includes, but is not limited to,
25 the right to personally appear at any administrative hearing held in this matter, to be represented by an
26 attorney at Respondents’ own expense, to confront and cross-examine all witnesses testifying at the
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1 hearing, to subpoena witnesses to testify at the hearing, to have an impartial administrative law judge
2 preside over the hearing as a hearing officer, and to have the matter judicially reviewed.

3 It is further stipulated and agreed that Respondents violated the Political Reform Act by
4 accepting campaign contributions in excess of the contribution limits, in violation of Government Code
5 Section 85301 (5 counts).

6 Respondents agree to the issuance of the Decision and Order, which is attached hereto.
7 Respondents also agree to the Commission imposing upon them an administrative penalty in the amount
8 of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000). A cashier's check from Respondents in said amount, made
9 payable to the "General Fund of the State of California," is submitted with this Stipulation as full
10 payment of the administrative penalty, to be held by the State of California until the Commission issues
11 its Decision and Order regarding this matter. The parties agree that in the event the Commission refuses
12 to accept this Stipulation, it shall become null and void, and within fifteen (15) business days after the
13 Commission meeting at which the Stipulation is rejected, all payments tendered by Respondents in
14 connection with this Stipulation shall be reimbursed to Respondents. Respondents further stipulate and
15 agree that in the event the Commission rejects the Stipulation, and a full evidentiary hearing before the
16 Commission becomes necessary, neither any member of the Commission, nor the Executive Director,
17 shall be disqualified because of prior consideration of this Stipulation.
