Manual Tally Operations commenced on Thursday, November 6, 2014 and ended on Tuesday, December 9, 2014.

Initial Random Selection: Serial numbered tickets 1-4684 representing 4684 Vote At Polls (VAP) precincts, and serial numbered tickets 6001-6343 representing 343 Declared Vote By Mail (VBM) precincts for the **November 4, 2014 General Election** were placed inside a rotating drum, and precincts were randomly drawn by Elections Official representatives and one (1) public observer. The initial random selection consisted of forty five (45) VAP precincts and six (6) Declared VBM precincts.

Additional Contests Selection: Twenty four (24) additional voting precincts were selected for contests that were not represented in the initial random selection. The Additional Contests Selection consisted of twenty three (23) VAP precincts and one (1) Declared VBM precinct.

System Card Readers: Serial numbered paper slips for precincts processed on three (3) System Readers (S11-R02, S08-R01, S13-R02) not represented in the initial 1% random selection were placed inside three (3) boxes and one (1) precinct was randomly selected from the box. To guarantee the transparency/randomness of the selection process, the box was securely closed and turned multiple times, before the drawing.
