RE: June 2016 Presidential Primary Election Voting Systems Incident Report and Manual Tally Report

Attached are summary documents detailing the various voting system incidents that occurred during the June 7, 2016 Presidential Primary Election. One report was compiled by the precincts section which received a total of 229 problems calls of which 17 were related to voting equipment. The other report was compiled by our voting systems and technology section which received a total of 152 problem calls of which 129 were related to voting equipment. The reports document various issues ranging from operator-system challenges to paper jams to scanners not operating. All incidents were resolved timely.

The 1% Manual Tally for this election included manual tally of 13 precincts and a manual tally of three individual contests in six precincts. The precinct-level review was shown to match in 11 of the 13 precincts. The two precincts that did not match were recounted on the central scanner which confirmed the manual tally results. The tally for individual contests showed five precincts matched the machine count and one precinct did not match the machine count. This precinct was recounted on the central scanner which confirmed the manual tally results.

Technical rovers replaced seven M100 scanner units that failed on Election Day after having processed ballots and these were manually tallied as required by the ES&S California Use Procedures. The results are included in the attached 1% Manual Tally report. Five of the recounted precincts matched the machine totals. The manual tally of the remaining two precincts indicate that ballots cards may not have been scanned into the original or replacement M100. The resulting machine recount verified the manual tally and the election night results were replaced with the machine recount.
