Dear Michael J. Scarpello, Registrar of voters:

Your letter said you would not participate. However, you must answer our questions per state elections code.

We asked you specific questions in our recent letter. According to elections code section 2300 a.9(B), we are entitled to an answer to our questions.

2300 a 9. (B) You have the right to ask questions of the precinct board and elections officials regarding election procedures and to receive an answer or be directed to the appropriate official for an answer.

Please answer the questions we put to you in our letter or else please direct us to an official who can.

Our questions are:

--> When will you do the random draw for the 1% manual tally (which is required by law). Do you do it before or after the election? Do you do it before or after the results are obtained on election night?

--> Will be possible to obtain a snapshot of your election data as we described in our letter? Do you post election results after completing election night counting?

--> Please treat the following as a public records request. Please provide an electronic file either to our FTP site or on your web site AFTER the election and BEFORE the 1% manual tally.
